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



AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 1 OF PART 1, CHAPTER XIII, PUBLIC LAW NO. 34-116, RELATIVE TO LIMITING THE PROHIBITION ON FIRST-QUARTER HIRING TO GOVERNMENT OF GUAM BRANCHES, DEPARTMENTS, AGENCIES, AND INSTRUMENTALITIES RECEIVING OPERATIONAL APPROPRIATIONS IN PUBLIC LAW NO. 34-116.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** Section 1 of Part 1, Chapter XIII, Public Law No. 34-116, is
3 hereby *amended* to read:

4 **“Section 1. Hiring Prohibited.** Unless otherwise specified in this
5 Section and notwithstanding any other provision of law, rule or regulation, a

1 prohibition on hiring *shall* take effect September 1, 2018 and *shall* remain in
2 effect through December 31, 2018; and *shall* be applicable to all positions in
3 the Executive, Legislative, and Judicial branches, to include all government
4 of Guam departments, agencies, and instrumentalities receiving operational
5 appropriations in this Act.

6 Beginning on September 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018, all
7 government of Guam branches, departments, agencies and instrumentalities
8 receiving operational appropriations in this Act may fill positions vacated due
9 *only* to retirement, termination, resignation, or death occurring on or after
10 September 1, 2018, at or below the grade-step level of the vacated position.
11 The Guam Department of Education is authorized to hire teachers, the
12 University of Guam is authorized to hire academic personnel, the Guam
13 Community College is authorized to hire academic personnel, the Department
14 of Public Works is authorized to hire Bus Drivers to fill vacant Bus Driver
15 positions, the Customs and Quarantine Agency is authorized to hire Customs
16 Officer I positions, and the Guam Election Commission is authorized to hire
17 temporary positions, if funded, specifically related to the General Election
18 held in November 2018. The Mayors Council of Guam (MCOG) is authorized
19 to renew limited term employment of personnel required to operate the Adult
20 Day Care and in-home and case management services as a result of the non-
21 responsiveness of third parties to a recent RFP for Adult Day Care operations.
22 In addition, Senior Center Operations personnel may be renewed to reflect the
23 new grant year and job order pursuant to the agreement between the Division
24 of Senior Citizens, DPHSS, and the MCOG.”
