**AN ACT TO AMEND § 102 OF CHAPTER 1, TITLE 1,
GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE
EFFECTIVE DATE OF EXECUTIVE ORDERS.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 that it is in the best interest of the people of Guam to be promptly apprised of
4 Executive Orders, and that publication by the Compiler of Laws is legal evidence of
5 Executive Orders pursuant to 1 GCA § 103(a)(5). *I Liheslatura* intends to allow for
6 increased transparency and more efficient government operations by requiring

1 prompt transmittal of Executive Orders to the Compiler of Laws and the Speaker of
2 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* (the Guam Legislature).

3 **Section 2.** § 102 of Chapter 1, Title 1, Guam Code Annotated, is *amended*
4 to read as follows:

5 **“§ 102. Effective Date of Statutes and Executive Orders.**

6 (a) Every law enacted by the Guam Legislature *shall* go into effect
7 at midnight of the day of its approval by the Governor, unless otherwise
8 provided therein.

9 (b) If a bill passed by the Legislature becomes a law without the
10 signature of the Governor by lying before him for ten (10) days (Sundays
11 excepted) while the Legislature is in session, such a law *shall* go into effect at
12 midnight on the last of such ten (10) days, unless otherwise provided therein.

13 (c) If a bill passed by the Legislature becomes law notwithstanding
14 the objections of the Governor, such law *shall* go into effect at midnight of
15 the day on which it was passed by the Legislature upon reconsideration by a
16 vote of not less than two-thirds of all members of the Legislature, unless
17 otherwise provided therein.

18 (d) The effective date of Resolutions of the Legislature which, by
19 their terms, authorize any act or confirm any action taken, *shall* be at midnight
20 of the day such Resolutions are passed by the Legislature, unless otherwise
21 provided therein.

22 (e) The effective date of Executive Orders *shall* be at midnight of
23 the day such Executive Orders are issued by the Governor and transmitted by
24 him to the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the Compiler of Laws, with
25 the exception of those Executive Orders declaring a state of emergency, which
26 *shall* also be transmitted but effective as indicated in the Executive Order.”
