1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI KUATTRO NA LIHESLATURAN GUAHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, Senior Softball USA is an organization of more than 1.5 million
4 men and women that unites senior softball players over the age of 40 throughout the
5 United States and the world by hosting international tours, tournaments and
6 championships; and

7 **WHEREAS**, seven teams from Guam — Armed Forces Guam 40 Major
8 (coached by Frank Camacho Jr.), Bud Light Guam 40 AAA (coached by Robert
9 Meno), Sindalun Guahan 40 AAA (coached by Jesse Aguon), Guam Seniors 50 AAA
10 (coached by Jesse Sablan), Guam Women's Team SOTTA 40 AA (coached by Alvin
11 Fejeran), Guam Women's Team Mighty 50 (coached by Gerald Santos), and FIGO
12 Islanders 40 AAA (coached by David Aguon) — competed in the 2017 season of the
13 Senior Softball USA international softball league; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the seven Guam teams as a whole earned the organization’s top
2 team award of the year, the 2017 Steve Simmons Memorial Sportsmanship Award,
3 which will be presented before an international stage of 613 teams at the 2017 Las
4 Vegas Senior Softball Association/Senior Softball USA World Masters
5 Championships Opening Ceremonies in Las Vegas on Sept. 29 for the men’s 50 teams
6 and on Oct. 6 for the men’s and women’s 40 teams; and

7 **WHEREAS**, in a letter notifying the teams of their award, Tom Hennessy,
8 Chief Executive Officer of Senior Softball USA, said, “This award transcends the
9 game itself. It stands for all that is good in the sport: passionate competition played
10 with good humor and good fellowship — that is the formula for good sportsmanship.
11 The beauty of good sportsmanship is that it incites a love of the game for all who
12 witness it. The Guam Teams have demonstrated the highest level of sportsmanship
13 and provide an example to teams throughout the sport;” now, therefore, be it
