Hafa Adai Senator Lee:

The Bureau requests that Bill No. 279-34 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill 279-34 (COR) is an act to amend §§ 5110, 5111, and 5112(a), all of Chapter 5, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated relative to the General Service Agency and the Chief Procurement Officer.

Section 2 of the proposed measure amends the General Service Agency's enabling act by detailing the responsibilities of the Chief Procurement Officer. Additionally, Section 2 states that the Chief Procurement Officer shall be accountable to the Director of the Department of Administration. Section 3 of the proposed measure further outlines the skills required to qualify as the Chief Procurement Officer. Section 4 of the proposed measure refers to the process of termination of the Chief Procurement Officer should such action be deemed appropriate by the Director of the Department of Administration and the Public Auditor.

The Government of Guam currently employs a Chief Procurement Officer within the General Services Agency. There is no mention within the proposed measure relative to compensation of the Chief Procurement Officer.

As such, the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
