Hafa adai Senator Lee:

The Bureau requests that Bill No. 308-34 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Legislative Bill No. 308-34 (COR) is an act to repeal and reenact §16311 of Article 3, Chapter 16, Title 3, Guam Code Annotated, relative to requiring an advisory referendum whereby voters of Guam are to symbolically express their approval or disapproval of any local tax increase proposed by the Guam Legislature, and providing that no increase shall take effect until ninety (90) calendar days have elapsed from the general election at which voters express their symbolic approval or disapproval.

The Bill, if passed, would repeal and reenact §16311 of Article 3, Chapter 16, Title 3, Guam Code Annotated and would do the following: change the subsection title to "Advisory Referendum on Tax Increases Required"; increases the effective date from thirty (30) calendar days to ninety (90) calendar days after the referendum for each proposed tax increase; and states how the referendum proposed to the voters will be written.

The proposed bill revises the current law which currently requires a referendum. Therefore, the intent of the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no new fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
