



**AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW § 57108 TO CHAPTER 57,
TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A NON-EXPIRING GUAM
IDENTIFICATION CARD FOR RESIDENTS AGED
SIXTY-FIVE (65) YEARS OR OLDER.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new § 57108 is hereby *added* to Chapter 57 of Title 10, Guam
Code Annotated, to read:

**“§ 57108. Guam Identification Card for Residents Aged Sixty-
five (65) Years or Older.**

1 Any resident of Guam aged sixty-five (65) years or older may apply for
2 a Guam Identification Card, which shall not expire. The card shall not be an
3 identification card compliant with the *REAL ID Act of 2005* (U.S. Pub. L. No.
4 109–13, 119 Stat. 231, 302) (2005) (codified at 49 U.S.C. § 30301 note) 119
5 Stat. 302) or any of its succeeding statutes. All fees and documentation as
6 required by the Guam Department of Revenue and Taxation for a non-REAL
7 ID Guam Identification Card shall apply. The notation “Non-Expiring” shall
8 be placed on the identification card.”

9 **Section 2.** This Act shall be effective thirty (30) days from the date of
10 enactment.

11 **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
12 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall
13 not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
14 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
15 severable.
