1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. § 1105 of Chapter 1, Title 2, Guam Code Annotated, is  
3 amended to read:

4 “§ 1105. Senators, Terms of.

5 Senators elected to the Guam Legislature shall hold office for a term  
6 of two (2) years and until their successors are elected and qualified.  
7 Commencing on the general election of 2020, there shall be no limit to the  
8 number of terms an individual may serve on a lifetime basis, except that an  
9 individual shall not serve more than three (3) terms on a consecutive basis.

10 The term of Senators elected to the Guam Legislature shall commence on  
11 the first Monday of January following the date of election.”

1           **Section 2.** § 6102 of Chapter 6, Title 3, Guam Code Annotated, is  
2 *amended* to read:

3           **“§ 6102. Terms of Office.**

4           Members of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* (the Guam Legislature) shall be  
5 elected for terms of two (2) years. Commencing on the general election of  
6 2020, there shall be no limit to the number of terms an individual may serve  
7 on a lifetime basis, except that an individual shall not serve more than three  
8 (3) terms on a consecutive basis.”

10           **Section 3. Severability.** *If* any provision of this Act or the application to  
11 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such  
12 invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be  
13 given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the  
14 provisions of this Act are severable.
