


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO I MAGA'HÅGAN GUÅHAN

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 8 OF CHAPTER XI, PUBLIC LAW 34-116, RELATIVE TO REDUCING THE GUAM RETIREMENT SECURITY PLAN APPROPRIATION BY TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$200,000); AND APPROPRIATING THE SAME FROM THE GENERAL FUND IN FISCAL YEAR 2019 TO THE GUAM POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR SECURITY CAMERAS AND RELATED EQUIPMENT.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** Section 8 of Chapter XI, Public Law 34-116, is hereby *amended*

3 to read:

1 **“Section 8. Guam Retirement Security Plan.** The sum of Three
2 Hundred Thousand Dollars (**\$300,000**) is hereby appropriated from the
3 General Fund to fund the Guam Retirement Security Plan established by
4 Public Law 33-186.”

5 **Section 2. Appropriation to the Guam Police Department.** The sum of
6 Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (**\$200,000**) is hereby appropriated from the General
7 Fund in Fiscal Year 2019 to the Guam Police Department to assist with the
8 deterrence and reporting of criminal activity. Funds *shall* be used to purchase,
9 operate, and maintain security cameras and related equipment in public areas.
10 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this appropriation *shall* continue to be
11 available until September 30, 2019, and is not subject to transfer or use for any other
12 purpose.

13 **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to
14 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity
15 *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect
16 without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
17 Act are severable.
