The Bureau requests that Bill No. 260-35 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 260-35 is an act to amend §40127 of Chapter 40, Title 5 Guam Code Annotated, relative to providing for the expedient appointment of members to the Municipal Planning Council (MPC) and safeguarding the invaluable role of the MPC. The proposed amendment would authorize the Governor of Guam to appoint a member to fill a vacant MPC position, with the approval of the Mayors' Council of Guam by resolution, should the vacancy be unfilled for more than sixty (60) days.

As such, the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
