AN ACT TO IDENTIFY AND AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNOR OF GUAM TO TRANSFER NO MORE THAN TWO MILLION DOLLARS (\$2,000,000) TO THE GUAM CUSTOMS AND QUARANTINE AGENCY FOR THE ARCHITECTURAL AND ENGINEERING DESIGN FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A CUSTOMS SATELLITE INSPECTION, HOLDING, AND SECURED STERILE FACILITY AREA.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Authorization.** Notwithstanding any other provisions of the law,
3 rule, or regulation to the contrary, *I Maga'hågan Guahan* is hereby authorized to
4 identify and transfer the sum of no more than Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000)
5 from the General Fund, any Special Fund, or any Federal Fund where such expense
6 is an eligible expense, to the Guam Customs and Quarantine Agency for the
7 Architectural and Engineering Design (hereafter referred to as the "A&E) for the
8 Construction of a Customs Satellite Inspection, Holding, and Secured Sterile Facility
9 Area (hereafter referred to as the "CSIHSSF"), pursuant to Public Law 34-112. The
10 transfer authority pursuant to this Section is above the transfer authority granted to *I*
11 *Maha'hågan Guam* pursuant to Public Law 36-54.

12 **Section 2. Reporting.** The Department of Administration and Guam
13 Customs and Quarantine Agency *shall* submit a report on the first (1st) day of each

1 month to the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, to update on the progress of this
2 Act, including, and not limited to any funds released to pursue the objectives of this
3 Act. The reporting *shall* continue until the funds transferred pursuant to this Act are
4 exhausted.

5 **Section 3. Release of Funds.** Notwithstanding any other provisions of the
6 law, rule, or regulation to the contrary, other than the funds needed for the A&E, no
7 funds *shall* be further expended under this Act.

8 **Section 4. Procurement.** Notwithstanding any other provisions of the law,
9 rule, or regulation to the contrary, all procurement associated with this Act *shall* be
10 pursuant to the procurement laws of Guam.

11 **Section 5. Return of Funds.** Notwithstanding any other provisions of the
12 law, rule, or regulation to the contrary, if the Guam Customs and Quarantine Agency
13 fails to complete the A&E for the construction of the CSIHSSF within one (1) year
14 from the enactment date of this Act, all remaining funds pursuant to this Act *shall*
15 be returned to the General Fund.

16 **Section 6. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
17 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall*
18 not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
19 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
20 severable.

21 **Section 7. Effective Date.** The Act *shall* be effective upon enactment.
