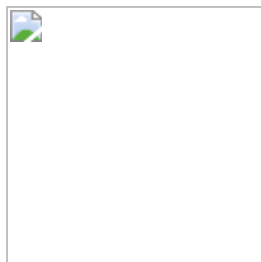

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 2:53 p.m.

Chairwoman Amanda L. Shelton:

Buenas and Hafa Adai everyone we are back from recess and we have a little change in our agenda today we will now be moving on to uh the appointment of Mr Edward F Ulloa to serve as a member of the University of Guam Board of Regents. Just for the record the time now is 2:53 p.m. and again this hearing was noticed on November 18th and November 20th. And we will now invite anyone who is here to testify uh for the appointment of Mr Ulloa to please join us at the table.

Okay. The government of Guam, the government, in control of the University of Guam, is vested in the Board of Regents. The Regents have General supervision over the university and control and the direction of all funds that are appropriated to the university. The board is responsible for setting the policies governing the duties conditions of employment compensation salary and emoluments of all employees at the university. The board is also responsible for the submission of an annual budget to the legislature. While the board has the authority to delegate such power as it may deem appropriate, it retains the ultimate responsibility for exercising its powers.

So, that is the role of the Board of Regents and today we have Mr Ulloa who is before us and some other folks who have signed in to give testimony. So I will begin on my right and then we'll work our way down and end with the appointee. So please just state your name for the record before you begin.

Sheila Conception, Vice President DZSP 21:

Good afternoon Madame chair, my name is Sheila Conception. I'm the vice-president and business director for DZSP 21 Amentum. It is my distinct pleasure and privilege just to be here to provide testimony for such a valuable member of our team, Edward Frank Ulloa (we call him Ed) for a seat at the University of Guam's Board of Regents.

Ed has been an executive leader within DZSP 21 for about 18 years which I have had the pleasure to work for and with. As one of the largest base operation Support Services contracts for the Department of Defense, DZSP provides non-stop facility utility transportation and Port Services for the Navy and its tenant commands. Serving the warf fighter over the last 19 years would not be possible without a vigorous IT program, all of which was managed by Ed and his team.

Ed is an outstanding professional mentor, colleague, and leader. His drive and influence have guided many DZSP 21 improvements, upholding the company's Standard of Excellence.

With the evolving IT industry Ed played a key project role that had made an impact in the information technology programs for both DZSP21 and DOD on Guam. For over 23 years Ed managed the programs for management information systems, cyber security infrastructure, and the development of Automated Business programs. DZSP 21 and Amentum would not be where we are today with the most valued asset of its people in which Ed is an outstanding representation of the employees we need to keep things moving forward to maintain exceptional performance.

I've often sought his guidance during challenging situations and collaborations have all ended in great successes. In all the years that I have known and worked with Ed I've developed an enduring respect for him and as a true testament to Ed's wonderful character I welcomed Ed as family and entrusted him to be a Godfather to my youngest daughter. He upholds his duty as a Godfather with pride.

Ed's character and Leadership, based on the vision of Excellence backed by experience and commitment gained through his tenure at DZSP 21 makes him an outstanding nominee for a seat on the Board of Regents. I was named one of the University of Guam's distinguished alumni in 2013 and I am confident that Ed will be a valuable addition and strong contributor to the success of the University's future. Please accept my highest endorsement of Edward Frank Ulloa for the prestigious opportunity to contribute to my alma-mater (Go Tritons) as a Board of Regent. Thank you very much for you time.

Chairwoman Amanda L. Shelton:

Charles Hazzard, CEO, DZSP 21 Amentum:

Hafa Adai Chair Senator Shelton, Senator Ljhan. My name is Charles Hazzard, I am the President of DZSP and Amentum Company. You just heard from our vice president.

So my wife and I moved to Guam. We live here. We bought a house. Four years ago I met both of these folks. And I've had a lot of experience understanding Ed's character.

Now what a lot of folks don't know as a contractor and with our systems, our MIS systems, we're under attack a lot. We're under attack by state actors and it is Ed's requirement to make sure we can stay straight with that. And we also do a lot of programming for our own sites and applications that help us do our work, and Ed leads that. So I've got to watch him for four years and how he leads and on top of everything recently uh he's had uh some folks leave to go to the government or offisland and I'm watching him develop a whole new set.

I do know about his piano playing and other great things about his character, but what I see is his quiet steady leadership. I have friends who are on the Regents and I'm friends with the president of UOG and she's the one that told me that Ed would be put up and I was very excited for him. I know how he is, I know how organized he is, and I know how much he cares. You couldn't pick a better person to be on the Board of Regents. I highly endorse Ed Ulloa. Thank you.

Chairwoman Amanda L. Shelton:

Thank you thank you very much Mr Hazzard. Ms. Roberto.

Kalyne Roberto:

Hafa Adai Madame Chair Senator Shelton, Senator Lujan. My name is Kalyne Roberto and on behalf of the Regent Nominating Council I am honored to speak in support of the appointment of Mr Edward Frank Ulloa for confirmation to the University of Guam Board of Regents.

Mr Ulloa is an executive leader with extensive experience in Management Information Systems, IT Project Management, Cyber Security, and Network Administration. Skills which are invaluable in today's rapidly evolving

technological landscape. Currently he serves as the MIS Manager at DZSP 21 where he has been instrumental in leading the company's IT department for over 17 years. His role includes managing IT support for all employees and overseeing mission critical applications for both DZSP 21 and its government clients.

Mr Ulloa's qualifications are particularly well suited for addressing the challenges and opportunities facing the University of Guam as it moves forward into an era where technology is central to its educational mission.

Chairwoman Amanda L. Shelton:

Thank you Ms. Robberto. Mr. Ulloa.

Mr. David Ulloa:

Thank you Madame Chair, distinguished member Senator Lujan. I'm David Ulloa, father of Edward. I could only, there's not much really to say other than Ed is fully qualified. I know that he'll be the best and give back to the community.

I encourage my kids, I have never worked for the government, but I have chaired GHURA, GPA, GTA, Seashore Commission, and that's my contribution to the community. I urge my family and other members to try and give back to the community and we hope that we did and I certainly encourage your consideration, favorable consideration, to confirm to his appointment to the board. Thank you very much.

Chairwoman Amanda L. Shelton:

Thank you Mr. Ulloa. Is there anyone else who wants to give testimony for the appointment of Mr. Ulloa? I'm sorry, I'm speaking to the crowd. Okay thank you very much so now we will move to the appointee. Please state your name for the record.

Appointee Edward Ulloa:

Good afternoon Madame Chair. My name is Edward Frank Ulloa. I'm very honored to be here. We rarely get out of the base so I had my big boss Chuck and Sheila, I kind of put them on the spot we weren't sure what to expect. This is our first rodeo.

I was very honored to be invited to apply for this position. You know it kind of came in a time when I was looking at education and how how I could give back. But I started many many years ago out in it by teaching computer classes and I taught every everything from intro to computers to all the Microsoft applications and I learned the joy of those moments when my students got it. You know they could, they were able to take command of the computer, get to do things they never understood or imagined. But I also quickly learned the pain of not planning lessons thoroughly, as my intro to computer students got stuck on lesson two, which was learning how to use

the mouse and my task there was to learn how to play solitaire. So they stuck on that lesson and then I eventually changed my lesson plan to put that at the end of the day so they don't stay all day on that lesson.

I've had a lot of, as Sheila had mentioned, we spent a lot of time supporting the Navy. I first started working for the BOSS contract in 2021 with Raytheon and I've had many many wonderful experiences over the years supporting the Navy.

A couple of highlights that come to mind is I actually had a project for DZSP where we relocated all the Navy leadership, all the Navy personnel, everything from their computers, phones, we built out infrastructure for them put them up in brand new renovated buildings. And that it was over 4 or 500 individuals including the Admiral. So that was one big highlight. And Sheila had mentioned an award-winning system that we wrote together. I helped lead a team that built something that is still in use today on the Navy side. It's you know a data management system but we're very proud of that application.

And in more recent years partnering with many of the three-letter agencies OSI, NCIS, FBI, NSA, and you know, helping advance our knowledge on the threats that threaten not only the Navy, us here on Guam, and really the whole Department of Defense. And very proud that we partner heavily with those folks and we try out new solutions, new tools, new strategies, and we work together on developing those.

Although it's been quite a few years since I was teaching computer classes, I do still, and you know in in line with the vision and the mission of UOG which is to enlighten, to discover and serve, that theme has been with us ever since the beginning. I've seen many many of my own staff move on to bigger and better positions in the government or to the federal government or out in the private sector. And I've seen many of my own colleagues go on to become leaders in our own organization, so it's something that we live every day and I'm really excited to hear about the challenges that UOG faces. I'm, like I said, I'm really brand new and looking forward to learning from the board what their agenda is.

You know education's always remained close in my heart and this is an opportunity to give back to the island which I wholeheartedly accept. And I

know, and I hope that you consider this. I really am grateful for this opportunity and I look forward to serving. Thank you.

Chairwoman Amanda L. Shelton:

Thank you very much Mr Ulloa. I will give the floor to my vice chair Senator Lujan. If you have any questions.

Vice Chair Senator Jesse Lujan:

Yes, thank you madam chair. Congratulations Mr Ulloa and actually wanting to to step up and and again provide public service to the people of Guam.

Have you had an opportunity to to meet with the with any other board members or sit in any of their meetings or consult with any UOG management?

Appointee Edward Ulloa:

Actually have not sir. You know it was just a quick reach out at the beginning of this summer and the process went by pretty quickly. Although I do happen to know a few of the present members and past members through, we're actually in the same age group. And also one of my classmates' wife sits on the board right now. So I'm a graduate of FD and that Brotherhood is strong so I was actually texted by my classmate, "Hey since you're going to be sitting on the board you'll see my wife more than I do so please say hi."

But actually you know it was a very quick process. You know I didn't really think we'd be here today. In fact when the governor's office had called me to sit down and meet you know and we were talking for about 20 minutes and I thought this meeting was because she was meeting all the candidates, you know. And I said you know so Madame Governor when you consider all the candidates, and she goes stop right there. You're my selectee, and I go "Really?" I was really surprised.

But I have not had a chance to hear their agenda and what the challenges they face today. I know some of them from the past and as friends I'm looking forward to understanding what their challenges are.

Vice Chair Senator Jesse Lujan:

I think, well it was mentioned you'd be a great asset of course to the university. Your expertise, your background.. Of course to the university you know and you heard earlier with the airport board confirmation, the challenges that we have there as well. But likewise, what I think when you bring to the University.

But let me ask you this, what do you foresee in regards to the university and to be able to entice folks. I mean we have, we see the great challenges that we have in our public school system, ok? Public school system and saying how our kids are really behind now in math and all that, right? But what do you see as that feeder school to the university and what we're trying to do, and entice businesses and higher paying jobs and we're in the technical world at this time, what do you foresee in trying to Foster that I guess that better partnership as a feeder school to the either the University or GC? What's missing in that equation there?

Appointee Edward Ulloa:

Well I could only speak from my experience, and one of the big thing, and you know even Miss Kalyne here she had touched on artificial intelligence, that's something that's growing. But even with our artificial intelligence and how those things and those systems can rapidly organize your thoughts, it still starts with a seed of creativity that I think as leaders is where we make that connection. How are you going to be creative today? What sparks you as a student? What sparks your imagination and then the tools will fall into place for you to use. What is it that keeps you up where you spend hours and hours into this subject, with creative tools etc. because the time just flies by you're having fun. I think it's reaching out and making that connection with students today and their creativity exploring that, building on that, and letting the tools follow will definitely foster a generation that's value adding to the community here on Guam or wherever else they may find them, their careers take them.

Vice Chair Senator Jesse Lujan:

I'm glad you said that, because because again you know we just need to get better at it right? We need to get better at it and I just don't know what is missing component is to try and get that into into the public schools. To be able to get them up and entice them. I mean even because you know when

you say that our students are not performing as well but I tell you what they're all on this. *(holds up cell phone)*

Appointee Edward Ulloa:

Yep.

Vice Chair Senator Jesse Lujan:

So you know I'm really dumb when it comes to this, but so I mean and these kids I tell you these kids with this so they there has to be something they can do with what they're doing here. And how with their lessons and how we can come together with that. Because I remember again when I was, then your dad remembers this, going to high school in order for us to learn how to type we had to go typing class.

Appointee Edward Ulloa:

Yep I was there. Yeah.

Vice Chair Senator Jesse Lujan:

Nobody takes typing calls anymore. It comes with the territory now. It's just innate. Right, it is innate now. Before you had to learn how to do ASDF and all that, right?. But it's innate now. But how do we transform that, how do we get that to be a part of that growth and not have a missing component in between.

Appointee Edward Ulloa:

I think making that connection between how they use this. My goddaughter who's 8 years old has a phone and they're carrying around an artificial intelligence system in their pocket.

Vice Chair Senator Jesse Lujan:

Yeah.

Appointee Edward Ulloa:

And a lot of these phones are more powerful than the computers we had a few years ago. But making that connection with how they'll use this to help them in their creative efforts. You know, not just make me a report to pass my class but the ideas behind that report. What was the subject that sparked it? What did that person live like back in that time? Use the AI.

In fact I was just talking with my son who recently got a job with the prestigious Bellagio hotel, and I was telling him about using AI to help him learn how he can be better for his customers. You know have AI help him find and use those systems that he has to use on a day-to-day basis to help his customers. Get better benefit for the money that they're spending.

So ways of making that connection and being creative with it, I think are the key. And education has the opportunity to help those kids get in touch with your creativity and then use these tools. You know they grow up with these tools younger and younger and younger and you know they know their ways around it even faster than you and I, probably.

Vice Chair Senator Jesse Lujan:

Oh absolutely.

Appointee Edward Ulloa:

But getting back to what's inside your heart you know and getting that creativity element out is key to using any tools, you know whether it's this or or any others and then of course honing your own skills. Practice, practice, practice. You know from a music background practice. Dance background practice practice. And then you augment it with these kinds of tools to help you. I think that's part of the answer.

Vice Chair Senator Jesse Lujan:

Sure. I'm looking forward and excited, again as I said it's a component, it's a very important component. I think and added a great asset to the Board of Regents at the University of Guam, but not only that but Guam in general. And with your presence there, as well I'm sure you'll work closely of course with the Education Policy Board of course, with your sister College next to you of course, Guam Community College. You know we're one, and we have

to come together as one. We can't be really separated and think we're going to accomplish something being separated. We've got to come together as one, to solve this situation that we're in right now. We've got great challenges, and, but we have great opportunities as well where at, we're situated. We have great opportunities, we have the challenges, we have the opportunities now we have to grab it.

Appointee Edward Ulloa:

Yeah. I spent a few minutes talking with Don Muna this past summer. You know, who's over at the community college and KGTF and you know he was sharing with me that all the big studios, Hollywood etc they're all looking for one thing: a story. They're looking for stories from around the world, you know. So whether we live here on Guam, whether we live in Asia, whether we live on the mainland, everybody has a story and helping our kids develop that story to tell of their life experiences you know will help us as we move forward. Not only for IT in general but just for life. What's our story going to be? Our legacy, right? But I'm really looking forward to the challenges that lie ahead and being part of this group.

Vice Chair Senator Jesse Lujan:

No absolutely. Then you got School of Engineering now and hopefully more schools will open up to keep our students here or wanting to come back. You know university is free here.

Appointee Edward Ulloa:

Yeah. One of the initiatives that I think we have in our company is the apprenticeships and internships that we're starting to build with UOG and so forth. So yeah we're definitely looking.

Vice Chair Senator Jesse Lujan:

I don't I don't mean free but I mean you know the application process. Well, wow, that's a Democrat talking. *[Laughter]* I don't mean free. But anyway congratulations and I look forward to voting in favor of your confirmation.

Appointee Edward Ulloa:

Thank you. Thank you Senator.

Chairwoman Amanda L. Shelton:

Thank you very much to my Vice Chair and thank you Mr Ulloa for your willingness to serve, to answering the call of the governor to serve on the Board of Regents at the University of Guam.

This is an institution that is very close to my heart and we've had, you know folks come in here from all walks of life being appointed to the board. Some in finance, business, entrepreneurs, engineers, all different people and I think that your background as an MIS manager will fit very nicely into this dynamic. And so I look forward to that.

Because one of the things that I think we need on the University of Guam Board of Regents is more innovation. And that's something that I've heard from all of your colleagues, and sitting here today, knowing that you wrote and building a system for a huge operation that's still being used today. Obviously your brain is innovating at your current position. And so you are highly respected for your character and your integrity. So those are all qualities that we need sitting on this board and I look forward to having you there. And although I don't know you well, we haven't worked together, I know that the Regent Nominating Council does a lot of good work. I sat on that Council. It was very difficult to vet each applicant to see you know all of their background and what they could bring to the table.

For me my number one priority is to always put students first and to ensure that they have opportunities to be able to complete their education and be put out into the world with the best background that they can get at the University of Guam to serve our community. Because you know everywhere, every department and agency has graduates from the University of Guam. I'm sure your company has many graduates from the University of Guam and we want to continue. We want to continue putting out, you know, well qualified, prepared individuals to work in every sector of our island.

And so I hope that you will bring that priority with you to the board. To put our students first and to make the University of Guam to be our leader not just for Guam but all of the students in our region, because we are serving more than just the people of Guam. That means everyone who comes here is

looking for an opportunity and we have to help to continue to create those opportunities.

So I look forward to your service on the board and I hope they're measuring you already for your regalia, you're going to walk in your first in the December graduation so we look forward to moving your appointment in this December session.
