**AN ACT TO ADD A NEW CHAPTER 14 TO TITLE 17 GCA DIVISION 2
GUAM DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, ENTITLED; "RESTRICTIONS
ON DANGEROUS WEAPONS."**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **SECTION 1.** A New Chapter 14 is hereby added to Title 17GCA, Division 2,
3 **Guam Department of Education, relative to Restrictions on Dangerous Weapons in**
4 **Guam's public school campuses and educational facilities, to read as follows;**

5 **"Chapter 14. Restrictions on Dangerous Weapons in Guam's**
6 **Department of Education public school campuses and educational facilities.**
7 **§14101. Legislative intent.** In order to ensure a safe environment that is
8 conducive to learning and protecting the health and physical safety of the
9 students and personnel in Guam's public schools and educational facilities, It is
10 the intent of I Liheslatura that no students, parents, visitors, administrative
11 personnel, professional staff, teachers, truant officers, school resource officers, or
12 any other persons, shall be authorized to carry any firearms (openly worn or
13 concealed), or any other items of a deadly/destructive nature as described under
14 the Guam Department of Educations' Board policies on to school campuses or
15 facilities under the purview of the Department of Education.

1 **§14102. Deadly and/or Destructive Weapons.** Firearms (openly worn or
2 concealed), guns, contrabands, and other deadly and destructive weapons shall
3 be prohibited on all Guam Department of Education school campuses and
4 educational facilities.

5 **§14103. Weapons Prohibition.** Guam Department of Education employees,
6 personnel, administrative personnel, teachers, staff, students, security personnel,
7 Truant Officers, School Resource Officers, visitors, and all other persons are
8 prohibited from bringing, displaying, wearing, and possession of deadly
9 weapons –openly worn or concealed- on any school campuses or facility under
10 the purview of Guam Department of Education, except as noted in **§14104.**

11 **§14104. Police Officers and Peace Officers Exempted.** Guam Police
12 Officers and other Peace Officers responding to requests for assistance and/or
13 emergencies on Department of Education school campuses or facilities, or to
14 conduct search and seizures, and/or to provide general assistance, or education
15 related activities under the purview of the Guam Department of Education shall
16 be exempt from this Act.”
