**AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SUBSECTION (m)(5) TO
SECTION 1 OF CHAPTER V, PUBLIC LAW 35-36 (THE
GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT OF 2020),
RELATIVE TO ESTABLISHING THE RATE OF
COMPENSATION FOR GUAM POLICE DEPARTMENT
CIVILIAN VOLUNTEER POLICE RESERVISTS.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that the Guam Police Department has instituted a Civilian Volunteer Police Reserve program that augments the work of the men and women in blue who serve our island community daily providing support whenever a call for help is made. Since the inception of this reserve program, volunteers have provided thousands of service hours in the protection of life and property by preventing crime, enforcing the laws, and maintaining order for the residents of Guam.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that an administrative oversight occurred when language was not included in the General Appropriations Act of 2020 to establish the rate of compensation for Civilian Volunteer Police Reservists.

1 Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to ensure that these
2 Civilian Volunteer Police Reservists are compensated for the time and efforts they
3 exert in ensuring the safety and security of our island with a commensurate stipend
4 for their contributions.

5 **Section 2.** A new Subsection (m)(5) is *added* to Section 1 of Chapter V,
6 Public Law 35-36, to read:

7 “(5) Guam Police Department Civilian Volunteer Police Reserve
8 Stipends. The Guam Police Department *shall* compensate each volunteer
9 serving in the Civilian Volunteer Police Reserve program who fulfills the
10 requirements for each month’s duty the amount of Five Hundred Dollars
11 (\$500.00) for that month, effective October 1, 2019.”

12 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* be effective upon enactment.
