- Appointed by *I Maga'hagan Guahan* on July 23, 2021 for Four (4) Years, July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2024;
- Appointment packet forwarded to *I Liheslatura* on July 26, 2021;
- Appointment packet forwarded to this Committee for public consideration on July 28, 2021.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

The public hearing was called-to-order at 2:00 P.M.

Vice Chairperson Amanda L. Shelton: And we will move on to our next agenda item, which is the appointment of Dr. Judith S. Flores to serve as a Member, Guam Educational Telecommunications Corporation (KGTF/PBS) Board of Trustees. If there's anyone here to testify. Dr. Flores. Okay, we have Mr. Joey, Franquez who is also a member of the Board of Trustees. Please, sir, go ahead.

Joseph D. Franquez: *Buenas yan Håfa Adai Todus Hamyo.* I'm here to get my testimony and support of Dr. Judy Flores and joining at the PBS board. I have known Judy for many years in regards to how important it has been to know where her heart lies in regards to our culture, our language and how she really implements her artistic values into how she works in the community and how her programs and her teaching, and really are emphasized in everything that she does.

I've worked with Judy in many different levels of projects in the past that have to deal with the perpetuation of language and culture. And I know that in working with her, with her projects down in *Inalahan* and *Gef pa'go* working with the instruction *Gefpa'go* Organization in building the village there. Which basically I had an opportunity to really appreciate during the time that my dad, who was a musician. had been given an opportunity to go there, to perform for the *man'amko* there on the weekdays, during the course of their stay at *Inetnon Gefpa'go*. And I thought that that was such a wonderful way to encapsulate the whole environment of what *Inalahan* really represents in their old impressions of the area of the local architecture with regards to the village and the kind of sentiments that people receive when they go there and experience the visit to *Inalahan*.

Um, even as a teacher, I think that Judy really goes over and beyond the whole aspect of how important art is and that through work with art that she's been able to really transcend the Chamorro culture and help to kind of more or less invite others to be able to experience that and to even go further and creating new ideas of how you can incorporate art in the culture and maintaining that moving forward. I really enjoy working with Judy because she really puts a lot of her passion into working with people and she's very people-oriented.

And I think that as a part of this board, she's going to bring on a completely different perspective from that aspect and how the board will be able now to have a sense of understanding and even more so enlightened the board to be able to think outside of the box, if you will, artistically and creatively, to be able to have PBS programs and projects to be aligned with some of these things that we really need to be able to connect with and our culture and our language is definitely a part of education. And I think that as long as

we're teaching and allowing students in our public school system or the private school system, to be able to benefit from this.

PBS has always been very supportive of education and that's the main mission of PBS. And I think that as a board member, that you will be able to contribute immensely in that area. And I'm really excited to say that I am very much happy to say that I'm very excited to see what we are going to be able to do at PBS with Judy's input from this point forward. So *Un Dangkulu na Si Yu'os Ma'åse*, Dr. Flores, and I really look forward to having you as a part of that.

Vice Chairperson Amanda L. Shelton: Thank you very much, Mr. Franquez, and I'd like to read into the record at this time, a testimony from the Chairman of the PBS Board of Trustees. And that is Mr. Donovan Brooks it reads, "*Håfa Adai*, Madam Chair, my name is Donovan Brooks, and I am the present Chairman of the Board of Trustees for KGTF/PBS Guam. In the event, I am unable to participate in the scheduled 2:00 PM confirmation hearing for Judy Flores. I would like to voice my unequivocal support for her confirmation. I have long admired her art. I think she is an exceptional artist, deserving of recognition, not only here but globally. I know she has a long history of community service on Guam. Most recently. With the Council on Arts and Humanities Agency. I am looking forward to working with her, to bring our community and public television closer together. Thank you for this opportunity to support Ms. Flores, his nomination, sincerely Donovan Brooks, chairman. Board of trustees, Guam Educational Telecommunications Corporation." Thank you very much, Mr. Brooks and I still see others on the line. If anyone else would like to provide testimony for Dr. Flores. Okay. If not, we will move on to the nominee herself. Dr. Flores, please go ahead. Please unmute yourself. Thank you.

Dr. Judith S. Flores: I knew I would forget that. Thank you Senator Shelton and the senators on the panel that are hearing this hearing. My name is Judith S. Flores. I am better known as Judy Flores and I am honored to be appointed to the Board of Directors of KGTF/PBS. This opportunity will continue my journey of service on several boards that help guide policy, vision, and activities in a broad range of artistic endeavors.

First of all, I'd like to say that I consider myself a daughter of Guam. Having been raised in Inalahan where my family came when I was 11 years old. And, uh, I was, uh, guided and, uh, loved and corrected and everything else by the *man'amko* there. And I am eternally grateful for that experience. I started my career as a secondary art teacher. In the Guam public schools in 1971. Ten years later, I moved to Guam CAHA as their first folk arts coordinator. Those were 10, very exciting years of identifying, documenting, and through promoting traditional arts and artists.

During that time, I worked with Inalahan leaders to create *Inetnon Gefpa'go*, Chamorro cultural center. We also developed networks across the Pacific and with the California

diaspora bringing our traditional artists to festivals and fairs in Long Beach, Fairfield, and the Festival of Pacific Arts in Australia, Samoa, and the Cook islands. During the time that I served for promotions of our artists, I was able to leverage video companies who produced weekly TV show to feature our local artists. It was a mutually beneficial arrangement with no production costs to the government. And I am always very pleased to see Tomblin Shook, at the legislature because we worked very closely together at that time. With the identification of traditional art forms. I sought the guidance of the National Endowment for the Arts Folk Arts Division to create our own masters award. In 2002, I was appointed to serve on the GVB board, providing 10 years of advising and encouraging the promotion of our own local artists. So my history of involvement in the arts will hopefully facilitate more networking among Guam's various arts related entities. I'm impressed by the talents, expertise, and administrative energy at KGTF/PBS.

I've seen them develop and promote more local talent that engages kids, adults, and Chamorro, and Micronesian cultures. I hope to facilitate or expand new networking and resources to help the board and administration realize their goals. Thank you.

Vice Chairperson Amanda L. Shelton: Thank you very much, Dr. Flores, congratulations on this appointment and *Si Yu'os Ma'ase* for your willingness to serve. I'd like to ask my colleagues if they have any questions for you. I'll begin with Committee members, Senator Tony Ada.

Senator V. Anthony Ada: Thank you. Madam Chair. Good afternoon, Dr. Flores and thank you for accepting the governor's nomination for the KGTF Board. Think probably the only question I would have for you, Dr. Flores is, you know, being, in this time of pandemic, what kind of programming would you like to see being offered on KGTF to help educate our children be it regular education or in our cultural and traditional values here on our island? And how soon would you like to see that implemented?

Dr. Judith S. Flores: Thank you for that question. I've seen this trend already starting because of more than a year of the pandemic and it's global, but I've also seen it on KGTF and I think we need to pursue those kinds of activities. First of all, I'd like to see more local programming and they have in recent years, I've really been impressed with what they've done with the local programs. For example, we've got Don and Kel there, who have started the film festival. So, we have those kinds of talented people on board and we have local filmmakers, local videographers. We have a lot of local talent and it always touches me when we see familiar things on a big screen or on our TV screen. And I think our kids need that. So yes, I would like to see KGTF continue on. Half that they are already embarking on and I serve a certain hope to help them.

Senator V. Anthony Ada: That's great to hear and, you know, I hope that, you know, the programming that goes out on KGTF continues to help our children, especially now

we're, they're not so much into face-to-face educational learning and you know, try to get them back into that norm of learning. But in the interim, we give them some type of system or some type of programming that can actually guide them towards their, you know, I see it every day. The challenge is, I mean, we've been on zoom all day long for confirmation hearings, proclamations for appointments and resolution presentations and the difficulty that I see the children going through, trying to stay on zoom learning and getting educated.

And I think that if we can just break away from that now and, you know, try and let them see what's going on. And I liked how you said that, you know, we continue to teach our children on our culture and that programming is going on in KGTF and with you there, I look forward to many good programs coming on and educating our children. So thank you for your willingness to step up and I look forward to voting on your confirmation as well. Thank you. Thank you, Madam Chair.

Vice Chairperson Amanda L. Shelton: Thank you very much, Senator Ada. Senator Brown?

Senator Joanne Brown: Thank you very much, Madam Chair. I'm sure I really don't have any questions for Ms. Flores. I think her, again, I mean all the creative arts over the years that she's brought to the island and her whole resume really speaks for itself. And I know she'll do very well and bringing her talents and her experience to our, to our public, uh, station and improving the programming. And very much like her comment earlier about doing more local programming, especially a lot of our young people now are not growing up with the same influences from grandparents that maybe our generation of the tail end was able to experience. So certainly look forward to her work and thank her for her interest in continuing her public service. With that, Madam chair, I'll conclude my comments. Thank you very much.

Vice Chairperson Amanda L. Shelton: Thank you very much, Senator Brown. Senator Taitague?

Senator Telo T Taitague: Thank you, Madam Chair. From Judy, I just sent you a picture by the way. I know you had the picture of my father when in the boy Scouts. And now, you'll have one of my mom Inalahan Bay 1955, helping to pull the net. And when you mentioned earlier how you grew up in *Inalahan* what you said that was really touching was the fact that the *man'amko*, they were there to guide you, but they also to tell you when you were wrong and my mom can attest to that too, as well. But, you know, I've known you for so many years and grew up knowing you in the village as the woman that is so helpful and, and caring and giving. And if we ever needed anything or inspiration, just go over to the corner of the village, you know, near the bridge where your parent's house was.

And we can get our inspiration from that. And you're continuing to do that by now, sharing your daughter's you know, with us, the people who have bombed to serve and the capacity that's going to definitely grow when it comes to the arts, you know, and on this island. Um, and we know you had to step down from CAHA and when she became the director. But I'm so glad you did step away from continuing to give back to the island, which you've done as well for many, many years and serving in this capacity at PBS. I know you're going to do an excellent job. I brought up earlier, to Betty Gayle about fundraising efforts, and I know that PBS is one area where they do quite a bit of fundraising.

In that perspective, then I'm pretty sure that you have some ideas to do that because I've seen you help, uh, other places like even the village in *Inlahan*, the hotel right outside of *Inlahan* working in that area and trying to build up you know, capacity and growing when it comes to helping our children moving forward in the arts and just in our heritage and our culture and keeping it strong. So the only thing I ask is to make sure please when you're writing down the words of the village that it's now spelled correctly, since we did the change of name change, I'm still hearing some of the mayors pronounced. You know, *Hagat Agat*, you know, and this is one way, we can do that through the education of our youth on the correct pronunciation and spelling of our villages.

We are not, you know, what is it called? Not changing it. We're restoring it. And I know that you're going to do a good job at doing that. So I'm very excited that you're back serving the people of Guam again, and the door is always open if there's anything else I could do. And I thank you too Sandy, you know, for your work at the agency and taking over Lasia, as well, you've got your hands full there. So appreciate again, all your hard work. Thank you, Judy. *Esta*.

Vice Chairperson Amanda L. Shelton: Thank you, Senator Taitague. And thank you to all my colleagues for being here today. And to Dr. Flores *Si Yu'os Ma'ase* again for being here for your testimony, answering our questions and your willingness to serve in this capacity. We look forward to completing your committee report and moving your nomination at the end of this month during session and supporting your nomination. I'd like to thank everyone again for being here.

Again, Ms. Betty Gayle, thank you for sticking around till the end and all those who were here to testify *Si Yu'os Ma'ase*. And with that these two appointments for Elizabeth C. Gayle to serve as a Member of *Hagātña* Restoration and Redevelopment Authority Board of Commissioners and Dr. Judith S. Flores to serve as Member, Guam Educational Telecommunications Corporation, (KGTF/PBS) Board of Trustees has been duly heard. And this public hearing is now adjourned at 2:52 PM.
