

Hafa Adai,

I have been nominated by Gov. Lou Leon Guerrero for a second term to the Guam Ethics Commission and seek your confirmation today.

I come to you with many years of experience in the private sector as well as the non profit sector, and five years in the government, here at the Guam Legislature. I recently retired as managing editor of Guampedia, an educational project I managed since its inception in 2002. I continue to serve as editor, though, now on a part time contractual basis. I have an extensive professional background in journalism, particularly pertaining to Guam and the Micronesian region.

My first term on the brand new Ethics Commission was for two years, all the while serving as Chairwoman. Since the Commission was formed in 2019 we have made much progress, but still have a ways to go before accepting complaints.

The Commission is very grateful to have received its first appropriation this fiscal year. We quickly began a search for an executive director and back in February hired Jesse Quenga to serve in that role. Subsequently we also hired two staff members, Donovan Alger and Pam Mabazza.

In the months that followed, the Commission had concluded major bids that include an office lease. This month GSA signed a lease with GCIC building. It will need to be furnished and communication lines installed, but we look forward to announcing the opening of the office in the near future.

Two bills have been passed by this body to strengthen the Commission, which we greatly appreciate. We have more independence now, and have been given a larger role in ethics training for Government of Guam employees.

With the local appropriation funds remaining, the Commission has prioritized two activities. The first is to secure a contract for legal services.

We are in the process of hiring a legal firm to guide us in establishing solid procedures for handling complaints. We want to be sure that we have a clear path once a complaint is filed, with transparent outcomes, all on a timely basis.

The second is the development on the Ethics Commission website and e-learning portal for the Ethics in Government program. The staff has begun identifying capable website

developers to work with us and create a robust website that includes a complaints portal as well as an educational portal.


Our goal is to have complaints and ethics education courses online for the most part. Of course some will prefer to file complaints in office and do in person learning, but we believe that most will find online learning and filing much easier. It will also be less costly for the Commission. Employees will simply register online, go through the training and be issued a certificate by e-mail. Directors will be informed on the training progress periodically.

Our staff is undergoing various training at present, including government of Guam procurement and investigative procedures, both needed for the Commission's work.

I consider good ethics of vital importance to good government. I know matters brought before the commission can have a big impact on lives and must be taken seriously. With 12,000 employees providing services to the people of Guam, we need to keep the CHamoru value of *afa'maolek* firmly in mind, so as to provide for a conscientious and just government service for the good of all.

The Guam Ethics Commission exists to provide a comprehensive accessible resource about ethics in government that will educate Government of Guam employees and handle complaints about unethical behavior and actions.

Commission term length is four years. I like to acknowledge the presence of Senator Frank Blas to join me. The conduct of this public hearing shall be those testifying on behalf of Ms. Shannon Murphy or have been invited to the panel and they are Mr. Jess Quenga and herself Ms. Shannon Murphy.

Written testimony shall be submitted to the committee, please provide my legislative staff with your written testimony for photocopying. Testimony may be read and lengthy testimony should be summarized about five minutes. Those testifying be allowed to present oral testimony. Once you're done, please remain in the room for questions or for additional testimony or as may be desired by members of the committee. Questions and testimonies shall be confined to the substance or nature of the agenda which is the nomination of Ms. Shannon Murphy. Personal inference as to the character or motive of any senator or any individual testifying is not permitted. Any violence of general rule of conduct will result in the removal from the public hearing room. Proper form decorum shall be practiced by all president of the public hearing room for these proceedings. Individuals who fail to maintain proper form decorum may be restricted from providing oral testimony and will be removed from the room. When you speak, please make sure that the microphone is "on" and that you speak into the microphone. You'll state your name and your title for the record. We will now begin to discuss the appointment of Ms. Shannon Murphy, Ms. Murphy if you can please go ahead and start your testimony.

**Shannon J. Murphy, Guam Ethics Commission Chairwomen:** [See testimony from Ms. Murphy].

**Chairman Joe S. San Agustin:** Thank you Ms. Murphy, Jesse do you have any testimony you'd like to provide on behalf of Ms. Murphy?

**Jesse John Quenga, Executive Director, Guam Ethics Commission:** Thank you, Honorable Chairman Senator Joe San Agustin and Senator Frank Blas Jr. for being here today. Yes, I just like to express my support for the nomination of Shannon Murphy to join another four years on the ethics commission. It was her leadership and temperament that's much appreciated, Shannon has been very engaged from the very beginning. Working with the staff and developing these procedures and as well as establishing our goals for the upcoming year so we look forward to more work. I think we haven't gotten yet with the complaints and we'd love to see Shannon on board as that process begins with her temperament. I think will be much appreciated, so thank you senator and I support the nomination.

**Chairman Joe S. San Agustin:** Thank you Mr. Quenga, I would like to also recognize that we're also joined by Senator Telo Taitague. And I'd ask my colleagues to go and ask questions and I'll ask final questions and close the nomination hearing. Senator Frank.

**Senator Frank Blas Jr.:** Thank you Mr. chair, and good morning to Jess and Shannon. Shannon, just one question. are you ready to do this?

**Shannon J. Murphy, Guam Ethics Commission Chairwomen:** I'm ready!

**Senator Frank Blas Jr.:** Thank you! Thank you, Mr. Chair.

**Chairman Joe S. San Agustin:** Thank you very much, Senator Telo, do you have any questions for Ms. Murphy?

**Senator Telo. T. Taitague:** I apologize for being a little late I knew it was your confirmation hearing Shannon, I've known you for the record for many, many years we don't want to go too far back. But this position that you're taking is very, very important, very important. Especially, when anything should come up that it is addressed right away, that it's not lingering you know. People need a clarification or justification right away.

**Shannon J. Murphy, Guam Ethics Commission Chairwomen:** Yeah.

**Senator Telo. T. Taitague:** And holding it on too long is an injustice. It's unfortunate on this island that people are deemed guilty before proven innocent.

**Shannon J. Murphy, Chairperson, Guam Ethics Commission:** Yeah.

**Senator Telo. T. Taitague:** And that's it's unfortunate that some people think that way, so that's why I think that having everything heard right away is really fair and important. Shannon, you've been at this for a while already can you tell me something that you see that could be improved on or something that you would like to see. There have been several bills have been passed, and if you can elaborate on how you're going to ensure that, that is followed through those bills and anything on improvement for where you're at?

**Shannon J. Murphy, Chairperson, Guam Ethics Commission:** Sure. the first bill that was passed recently was to do with the independence of the commission which we believe was necessary so that there isn't any people thinking that we're favoring somebody you know with a positive outcome due to our connection to them in the government. Like with the Governor's Office and so, that was really important and we're happy that, that happened. The other bill was the one that Sabrina Perez wrote and that was about doing ethics and government training for all the government employees not just the directors and board members. So, which is like 12,000 people so, that's like a big job for us and we're really excited about that. We believe we think that's the right thing to do and then people can't say well I didn't know! because they've already taken the training right so, that we're really excited about that. We're, so now that we have our office, we have our staff the next thing is to create these two programs one is the ethics and government training and the other is to work on the whole complaint process. Which we believe is you know we've just hired an attorney so, that's going to be the focus now for this summer. So now that we have those two things underway, we've got to get that all straightened out make sure that we really feel comfortable with it before we actually start taking some complaints. Because we don't want to like get complaints and then just like languish in our office. We want things to move quickly and make sure that it's done properly so we just got to do it right and that's what our focus is. Yeah.

**Senator Telo. T. Taitague:** Sounds good, okay you know you're both the position that you take on especially in this this arena of ethics is it can be very muddy and sometimes messy and politics gets in the way many times. So, I'm going to ask you if something comes in front of you of something political in other words to pressure you on somebody's outcome of a case will you be morally and ethically bound by your position to be fair honest and not allow any political agenda to get in the way of what's right?

**Shannon J. Murphy, Guam Ethics Commission Chairwomen:** Well, yeah, I don't see that as a problem at all of our board members none of them have family members in the government of Guam or immediate family members anyway. We're all very committed to seeing the

government of Guam be uplifted on the whole ethical behavior. So, we're working on our mission statement right now and all that you know and we're just feeling really positive about it so I hope you will too.

**Senator Telo. T. Taitague:** Well thank you so much for stepping up especially at this particular type of board it's very, it's going to be difficult for you I greatly appreciate you wanting to serve again the people Guam as long as I've known you've always been on this island serving us and but in this capacity it gets pretty contentious sometimes, So, I leave my door open my office open to you if you have any issues especially when you're trying to be ethically and morally correct and someone's giving you a hard time please come see me.

**Shannon J. Murphy, Guam Ethics Commission:** Okay.

**Senator Telo. T. Taitague:** I'll be happy to help and back up what you have with what is right morally and ethically right before you especially sticking to your guns and people harassing you. You come see me okay I will be there to stand next to you okay.

**Shannon J. Murphy, Guam Ethics Commission Chairwomen:** Okay.

**Senator Telo. T. Taitague:** Okay same to you Jess as well Mr. Quenga and please. *Si Yu'os Ma'ase'* Mr. Chair.

**Chairman Joe S. San Agustin:** Thank you Senator Telo, Ms. Shannon you know I appreciate your willingness to serve in this position again to continue serving and I'm very confident that your time on the board will be effective and productive. You know I'm in support of your nomination, it's obvious that you got two other supporters so I don't believe we're having to have a problem on this upcoming session on putting the packet together and sending it through. So, with that, will conclude the public hearing on your nomination Ms. Murphy.
