WHEREAS, it is the sense of I Liheslaturan Guåhan to recognize the life and accomplishments of those distinguished citizens of this great island, and it is the custom of I Liheslaturan Guåhan to commend those public servants who have devoted themselves faithfully serving in the best interests of this community and the needs of its residents; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Colonel Dan J. Shinohara attended and graduated from the United States Air Force Academy, which has one of the most prestigious and respected academic programs in the nation, having only an eleven percent (11%) acceptance rate. Due to his academic achievement, leadership performance and athletic participation, Lieutenant Colonel Dan J. Shinohara was chosen to attend this prestigious academy and graduated in 2000; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Colonel Dan J. Shinohara furthered his education by attending Basic Communications Officer Training at Keesler Air Force Base in Mississippi, and finished in 2001; completing Squadron Officer School at Maxwell Air Force Base in Alabama in 2006; completing Air Command and Staff College at Maxwell Air Force Base in 2010; completing Joint and Combined Warfighting School at the Joint Forces Staff College in Virginia in 2011; and completing the Masters Business Administration at the American Military University in West Virginia in 2014; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Colonel Dan J. Shinohara's career with the U.S. Air Force began in June of 2000 in the College of Charleston as a Gold Bar Recruiter in South Carolina, where he would serve until May of 2001; and

WHEREAS, following his service at the College of Charleston, Lieutenant Colonel Dan J. Shinohara then served at Bolling Air Force Base in Washington, D.C. as a Plane Flight Deputy Commander until May of 2002; as an Executive Officer until July of 2003; as a Support Flight Deputy Commander until August of 2004; and as the Info Systems Flight Deputy Commander until October 2005; and Lieutenant Colonel Dan J. Shinohara's devotion to the Bolling Air Force Base in Washington, D.C. and the United States Air Force was shown throughout his four (4) years of service; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Colonel Dan J. Shinohara worked as the Director of Operations at Robins Air Force Base in Georgia until October of 2008; and he then served as the Project Lead in the Joint System Integration Center in Virginia until October of 2012; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Colonel Dan J. Shinohara began his service at Peterson Air Force Base in Colorado; and throughout his time there, he served as an Enterprise Networks Chief until October 2013, and as a Computing Infrastructure Chief until November 2015. Lieutenant Colonel Dan J. Shinohara ended his service in August 2016 closing his four (4) years of service with the Peterson Air Force Base as a Common Computing Branch Chief; and

WHEREAS, in June 2018, Lieutenant Colonel Dan J. Shinohara worked as a Technical Services Deputy Director at Scott Air Force Base in Illinois, and he then served as the Commander at Joint Base Langley-Eustis in Virginia until July 2020; and Lieutenant Colonel Dan J. Shinohara also worked as the Resources Deputy Division Chief at the Pentagon in Washington, D.C. until July 2022; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Colonel Dan J. Shinohara is currently the Enterprise Services Portfolio Manager for the Department of the Air Force (DAF) where he manages the \$591 Million Dollar portfolio by providing strategy and guidance for the delivery of productivity and collaborative services in support of airmen and guardians across the globe; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Colonel Dan J. Shinohara has served honorably with the United States Air Force and has previously been the Deputy Division Chief of Resources for the DAF Chief Information Officers. He has overseen the plans, programs, budget, and execution of DAF Cyberspace and IT investments that are valued at \$8 Billion Dollars per year. Lieutenant Colonel Dan J. Shinohara was also the Commander of the 83rd Network Operations Squadron, Joint Base Langley-Eustis, Virginia; and while serving there, he held joint headquarters, major command, field operating agency and squadron assignments; and in these positions, Lieutenant Colonel Dan J. Shinohara directed network operations and enterprise core service management, he organized coalition command and control interoperability testing, he obtained funding for and managed multi-million dollar network infrastructure programs, and he led cyber support operations for the Joint Surveillance Target Attack Radar System (JSTARS) platform; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Colonel Dan J. Shinohara's commitment to service in the United States Air Force extends above and beyond as is evident through his extensive service, work ethic, and his unwavering dedication; and




