BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA'TRENTAI SIETTE NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, it is the sense of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to recognize and honor those who cultivate this great island's culture and traditions, and devote of themselves, faithfully serving our island through the commemoration of their parish community; and

WHEREAS, *San Isidro*, translated from "Saint Isidore," was born in Madrid, Spain, in the latter half of the twelfth (12th) century, and lived a simple life with his parents. He married at a young age to Maria Torribia, also known as Maria de la Cabeza, who after passing was canonized into sainthood by the Catholic Church. During his life he worked as a humble farmer, tilling fields and devoting himself to God, often spending his days praying, attending church, and serving the less fortunate; and

WHEREAS, *San Isidro* died on May 15, 1120, at the age of sixty (60), and the Catholic Church canonized him as a Saint on March 12, 1622; and

WHEREAS, the *San Isidro* Chapel in *Malojloj* became a reality in 1948 through a donation of land from local resident, Joseph Meno and was officially declared *San Isidro* Parish on July 21, 1973, remaining a symbol of unity and hard work to the community of *Malojloj*; and

WHEREAS, since 1973, the community of *Malojloj* has celebrated the feast day of *San Isidro*, the Patron Saint of the farmer; and this year marks the celebration of the Golden [Fiftieth (50th)] Jubilee Year Anniversary of *San Isidro* Parish; and

WHEREAS, the people of *Malojloj*, a farming community since the 1930s, believe that through the intercession of *San Isidro* they have received blessings of a rich harvest and an abundance of food to feast on; and

WHEREAS, in the wake of Typhoon Mawar which made landfall on Guam on May 24, 2023, the community of *Malojloj* and parishioners of *San Isidro* Catholic Church have continued to persevere through the island's recovery and remained diligent in their service to their community and their Patron Saint, *San Isidro* as they have done numerous times before; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'trentai Siette Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam, recognize the parishioners and community of *Malojloj*; and commend them on their diligent commemoration of the Golden [Fiftieth (50th)] Jubilee Year Anniversary of *San Isidro*, the Catholic Patron Saint of farmers and the parish, in the wake of Typhoon Mawar; and be it further




