WHEREAS, in 2023, this selfless expenditure of time and resources included the expeditious, extensive restoration and hardening of the Guam Chinkon Shrine (Guam Sea of Souls Shrine) after the significant damage it sustained because of Typhoon Mawar; and

WHEREAS, these efforts serve as an example to all people everywhere of the degree of peace and understanding that can be achieved when these endeavors are undertaken cooperatively by the descendants of the former enemies of war; and these cooperative endeavors also make Guam a better place to live and a more attractive destination to visit; and

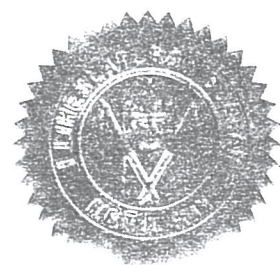




