WHEREAS, in September 2006, the Division of Environmental Health of the Guam Department of Public Health and Social Services kicked off its First (1st) Annual Guam Food Safety Education Month to coincide with the observance of National Food Safety Month, which continued to be observed until 2015; and

WHEREAS, after an eight (8)-year lull, the observance of Guam Food Safety Education Month has returned to focus on the importance of food safety; and although Guam has not experienced any foodborne illness outbreaks in years, the Division of Environmental Health continues to encourage the public to remain vigilant and take the necessary steps to protect themselves from harmful microorganisms; and

WHEREAS, the intent of Food Safety Education Month is to spread awareness to the community on steps to prevent food poisoning and provide education on food safety by expanding the event to the entire island community with activities for students, other regulatory entities, non-governmental organizations, and the general public; and

WHEREAS, this year, the Guam Food Safety Education Month theme is "When Baxter Attacks, the Food Guardians Fight BAC!", where the Division of Environmental Health unveiled the food safety mascots created by Reo Okawa and Koyuki Santos, previous victors of the Annual Guam Food Safety Education Month Poster Contest; and
