**WHEREAS**, the Fonei Achocho Senu Athletic Organization (FASO) has also performed many community outreach projects outside of sports, such as an outreach in *Harmon* with the Chuukese Singers Team RESIM; the donation of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), blankets, and toilet tissue to Chuukese communities in Saipan in 2018; organizing clean-up projects in 2018; and working with Senator Clynton Ridgell, the Federated States of Micronesia (FSM) Consul General, and Ayuda Foundation to organize a rice and water relief drive for Chuuk and other outer islands that were affected by Typhoon Yutu in 2019; and
