**WHEREAS**, on June 22, 2024, Patrick James Flores Uncangco demonstrated bravery and civic responsibility while driving on *Macheche* Road in *Dededo*, Guam, as he witnessed a man who was recklessly driving a white small crossover SUV; and

**WHEREAS**, the assailant was speeding and attempting to pass several cars, ultimately losing control and nearly endangering pedestrian lives, before veering into oncoming traffic, hitting a pole and flipping his SUV within five (5) feet of Patrick Uncangco's truck; and

**WHEREAS**, despite the danger, Patrick acted swiftly and decisively when the assailant attempted to flee the scene, successfully apprehending him and detaining him until the Guam Police Department (GPD) arrived. According to the GPD, the driver who was detained by Mr. Uncangco was armed with a gun and was using a stolen car; and

**WHEREAS**, the assailant was arrested on suspicion of theft of motor vehicle, illegal possession of a firearm, unlawful discharge, reckless conduct, terrorizing, destruction of evidence, reckless driving, leaving the scene of a crash with property damage, and execution of a search warrant; and

**WHEREAS**, the driver had been on the run from authorities and was wanted in connection to last month's shooting in *Maite* that left a teenage girl injured. Investigators mentioned the shooting was among a handful of other violent crimes reported in recent months believed to be gang-related; and

**WHEREAS**, Patrick Uncangco is a good Samaritan and a lifelong martial artist, using his skill set to detain the assailant and keep him from fleeing the scene until police arrived. His courageous actions not only resulted in the capture of a repeat offender but also significantly contributed to the safety and well-being of the community; now therefore, be it
