



3 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Naomi Cruz Taitingfong is married to William P. Taitingfong;
4 mother to William, Raina, and Matthew; and grandmother to Tåga and Nina'I; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Taitingfong is 1984 graduate of Notre Dame High School in
6 Talofofu and received her Bachelor's Degree from the University of Guam (UOG) in
7 1989. She later returned to UOG to further her education and received her Master's
8 Degree in 1998; and

9 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Taitingfong began her career with the Guam Department of
10 Education (GDOE) in 1989 as a limited term, full-time teacher at M.U. Lujan
11 Elementary School and became a full-time teacher at Inarajan High School in 1992; and

12 **WHEREAS**, by 1997, Ms. Taitingfong worked her way up and became an
13 Assistant Principal of Piti Middle School before being detailed as a School Program
14 Consultant with Curriculum and Instruction; and

15 **WHEREAS**, in December of 2000, Ms. Taitingfong enlisted in the Guam Air
16 National Guard as a desire to further serve her island and country; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Taitingfong spent several years at John F. Kennedy High
2 School as an Assistant School Principal before being transferred to L.P. Untalan Middle
3 School; and

4 **WHEREAS**, in 2005, Ms. Taitingfong was promoted to Secondary School
5 Principal, remaining at L.P. Untalan until 2009 when she was transferred to Agueda I.
6 Johnston Middle School; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Taitingfong spent her career enriching the lives of the children
8 she taught, the colleagues she worked with and the staff that she guided while serving
9 her country and taking care of her family; now therefore, be it

10 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'trentai Siette Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
11 on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize Naomi Cruz Taitingfong on the occasion of
12 her retirement from the Guam Department of Education; and commend her for her
