1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'TRENTAI SIETTE NA LIHESLATURAN***
2 ***GUÅHAN*:**

3 **WHEREAS**, The *Mangilao* Mayor’s Office, the *Mangilao* Municipal Planning
4 Council, and the residents of the municipality of *Mangilao* will hold their fourteenth
5 (14) annual “*Mangilao Donne’* Festival,” showcasing its extensive use of *donne’*, also
6 known as the boonie pepper, which serves an integral part of Guam’s culture and has
7 steadily become a culinary staple that adds flavor and spice to a wide assortment of
8 Guam’s local cuisine; and

9 **WHEREAS**, in 1920, Naval Governor Henry B. Price launched a vigorous
10 “back-to-the-soil movement” to assist *CHamorus* in the development of agriculture and
11 self-sufficiency, encouraging the local population to focus on farming. To encourage
12 people to live on their farms, Prince built a road into the area, followed by the Mangilao
13 School in 1926, fostering development of the community; and

14 **WHEREAS**, after World War II, Mangilao continued to be Guam’s main
15 farming area, which included major crops such as tapioca, cassava, corn, mongo beans,
16 tomatoes, and most notable, peppers, known as *donne’* in *CHamoru*; and

17 **WHEREAS** the *Mangilao Donne’* Festival continues to grow every year
18 attracting Guam residents and visitor to the municipality of *Mangilao* to enjoy different
19 food vendors, entertainment, and contest; and

20 **WHEREAS**, the *Mangilao Donne’* Festival, is a great opportunity for the
21 residents of *Mangilao* and the people of Guam to come together and demonstrate the
22 different uses of *donne’* and the significance to Guam’s culture.

23 **WHEREAS**, the *Mangilao Donne’* Festival, serves as an incubator for small
24 businesses and gives an opportunity for members of our community to showcase their
25 products and talents to the other local residents and to visitors from around world; now
26 therefore, be it

27 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'trentai Siette Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
28 on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and congratulate Mayor Allan “Al” R.G.
