4 August 23rd, 2024, after completing forty-one (41) years of government service at the
5 former Department of Commerce and the Bureau of Statistics and Plans; and

7 1981; and

8 **WHEREAS**, on September 6, 1982, Anton began her career with the government
9 as an Auxiliary Worker with the Department of Commerce under the Customs and
