1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**  
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI SIETTE NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, the 2024 Amateur Athletic Union (AAU) Junior Olympic  
4 Games, held in Greensboro, North Carolina, brought together nearly fifteen  
5 thousand (15,000) young athletes from across the nation to showcase their talents  
6 and athleticism in twelve (12) different sport competitions. Among the participants  
7 were close to one thousand (1,000) swimmers competing in over seventy (70)  
8 individual events and relays; and

9 **WHEREAS**, fourteen outstanding swimmers from the Amphibious Aquatics  
10 Guam Swim Team earned the prestigious honor of qualifying and competing in the  
11 2024 AAU Junior Olympic Games, including 12 & under swimmers: Matua  
12 Camacho, Tanom Camacho, Demi Blu Hurchanik, Logan Jun, Nina Lee, Hyemi  
13 Reyes, Gabriel Rodriguez, Naiatea Wooley; and 13 & over swimmers: Logan  
14 Gandaoli, Mia Lee, John Moore IV, Keana Santos, and Isla Rodriguez; and

15 **WHEREAS**, these athletes exhibited remarkable skill, determination, and  
16 sportsmanship in their competitions, proudly representing Amphibious Aquatics  
17 Guam and the island of Guam while embodying the *Håfa Adai* spirit; and

1           **WHEREAS**, Amphibious Aquatics head coach Andy Lee and the team’s  
2 coaches have played an instrumental role in guiding and supporting these athletes,  
3 fostering a culture of excellence and an environment for athletes to cultivate their  
4 skills; and

5           **WHEREAS**, the families of these athletes have provided unwavering support,  
6 encouragement, and dedication, contributing to the success and development of  
7 these young swimmers; and

8           **WHEREAS**, the participation of these young athletes from Amphibious  
9 Aquatics in the 2024 AAU Junior Olympic Games serves as an inspiration to the  
10 community and exemplifies the values of hard work, perseverance, and teamwork;  
11 now therefore, be it

12           **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'trentai Siette Na*  
13 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize the  
14 Amphibious Aquatics Swim Team for their outstanding participation in the 2024  
15 Amateur Athletic Union (AAU) Junior Olympic Games; and be it further
