Relative to recognizing the people of the Republic of China (Taiwan) on the occasion of the One Hundred Thirteenth (113th) “Double Tenth National Day” celebration on October 10, 2024.

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI SIETTE NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, on October 10, 2024, the people of Taiwan will celebrate its One
4 Hundred Thirteenth (113th) anniversary of the “Double Tenth National Day,” marking
5 the historic establishment of the Republic of China (Taiwan) in 1911; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the Republic of China (Taiwan) continues to play a critical role in
7 the Asia-Pacific region, not only as a beacon of democracy but also as a leader in
8 technological innovation, global health, and environmental sustainability, maintaining
9 strong relationships and economic ties with countries around the world, including the
10 United States and Guam; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Taiwan’s 113th “Double Tenth National Day” will be a time of
12 reflection and celebration for the Taiwanese people as they honor their democratic
13 achievements, resilience in the face of challenges, and ongoing contributions to global
14 peace and prosperity; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Guam and Taiwan share a profound connection rooted in our
2 Austronesian heritage, with the CHamoru people of Guam and the Taiwanese
3 Aborigines preserving this bond through ongoing cross-cultural exchanges; and

4 **WHEREAS**, since 1973, the people of Guam have enjoyed a special Sister-City
5 relationship with the people of Taipei City, fostering mutual benefits in cultural
6 exchanges, educational opportunities, healthcare services, and economic investments;
7 and

8 **WHEREAS**, this fifty-year relationship has deepened ties between Guam and
9 Taiwan, forging lasting friendships and creating economic opportunities for our islands;
10 and

11 **WHEREAS**, Guam has further strengthened its connections with Taiwan by
12 establishing two additional sister-city relationships: with Taoyuan in December 2021,
13 a major industrial and technology hub hosting Taiwan’s largest international airport,
14 and with Taichung in February 2022, the second-largest city in the Republic of China
15 (Taiwan); and

16 **WHEREAS**, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* has previously adopted several Legislative
17 Resolutions commending Taiwan’s efforts to promote global health, supporting
18 Taiwan’s observer status at the World Health Assembly of the World Health
19 Organization (WHO), and advocating for Taiwan’s inclusion in United Nations
20 Specialized Agencies such as the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO), the
21 United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC), and the
22 International Criminal Police Organization (INTERPOL); and

23 **WHEREAS**, the people of Guam express deep gratitude for the numerous
24 contributions of the Taiwanese government, the Taiwanese communities on Guam, and
25 the Taipei Economic and Cultural Office in Guam; now, therefore, be it

26 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'trentai Siette Na*
27 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, congratulate the
28 people of the Republic of China (Taiwan) on the occasion of its One Hundred Thirteenth
29 (113th) “Double Tenth National Day” on October 10, 2024; and be it further

1 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules
2 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of
3 the same be thereafter transmitted to His Excellency Lai Ching-te, President, Republic
4 of China (Taiwan); to the Honorable Lin Chia-lung, Minister of Foreign Affairs,
5 Republic of China (Taiwan); to the Honorable Chia-ping Liu, Director General of the
6 Taipei Economic and Cultural Office in Guam; to the Honorable Tai Hsi-chin, Speaker,
7 Taipei City Council; to the Honorable Chiang Wan-an, Mayor of Taipei City; to the
8 Honorable Chiu Yi-sheng, Speaker, Taoyuan City Council; to the Honorable Chang
9 San-cheng, Mayor of Taoyuan City; to the Honorable Chang Ching-chao, Speaker,
10 Taichung City Council; to the Honorable Lu Shiow-yen, Mayor of Taichung City; and
11 to the Honorable Lourdes A. Leon Guerrero, *I Maga'hågan Guåhan*.
