



1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'TRENTAI SIETTE NA LIHESLATURAN***  
2 ***GUÅHAN*:**

3           **WHEREAS**, Michael A. Guzman resides in Baza Gardens, Yona with his wife,  
4 Janet N. Guzman, where they are parents to three (3) children, Miklenne, Jasen and  
5 Madelene, and four (4) grandchildren, Vicente Jose, Kymani Reign, Riley Summer and  
6 Colion; and

7           **WHEREAS**, Michael is the son of Michael J. Guzman and Maria D. Roberto;  
8 and

9           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Guzman graduated from Father Duenas Memorial School in  
10 1990, upon which is attended the University of Guam where he would obtain a Bachelor  
11 of Arts Degree in Elementary Education in the fall of 1997; and

12           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Guzman joined the Guam Army National Guard as an E4  
13 specialist with the Engineering Unit; and

14           **WHEREAS**, while serving his country, from 1990 to 2009, Mr. Guzman's  
15 Military Occupational Specialty (MOS) was Electrician and he served during Operation  
16 Enduring Freedom from 2005 – 2006; and

1           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Guzman began his service to the Government of Guam in 1990  
2 as a Full-Time Substitute at P.C. Lujan Elementary School until 1992, where he was a  
3 School Aide at George Washington High School until 1996; and

4           **WHEREAS**, in fall of 1998, Mr. Guzman completed student teaching with  
5 Master Teacher, Mrs. Pearl Tyquiengco, at Merizo Martyrs’ Memorial School  
6 (MMMS) and began teaching at the same school where he serve in various capacities  
7 as a first, second, third, and fourth grade teacher as well as a Gifted and Talented  
8 Education (GATE) teacher until May of 2024; and

9           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Guzman has supported and assisted various school  
10 organizations and activities such as being a coach for the Guam Federation  
11 Internationale de Football Association (FIFA/GFA) school league Soccer League,  
12 Guam Police Department (GPD) Kickball Tournament, Youth Crime Watch (YCW),  
13 Flag Detail, Stock Market Game, and Math Olympiad over his thirty-four (34) years of  
14 service in education; now therefore, be it

15           **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'trentai Siette Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,  
16 on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize Michael A. Guzman on the occasion of his  
17 retirement from the Guam Department of Education; and commend him for his thirty-  
18 four (34) years of service to the Government of Guam; and be it further
