3 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Ma Luisa Gwenn F. Pabellano-Tiongson is a highly esteemed
4 adult neurologist specializing in neuromuscular and electrodiagnostic medicine, known
5 for her exceptional skills, dedication, and compassionate patient care; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Pabellano-Tiongson currently serves in several prestigious
7 institutions in the Philippines, including The Medical City in Ortigas, St. Luke's
8 Medical Center in both Global City and Quezon City, the University of the East Ramon
9 Magsaysay Memorial Medical Center Hospital, Quirino Memorial Medical Center in
10 Quezon City, and Sacred Heart Hospital of Malolos in Bulacan, where she has made
11 significant contributions in the field of neurology; and Dr. Pabellano-Tiongson
12 currently serves in several prestigious institutions in the Philippines, including The
13 Medical City in Ortigas, St. Luke's Medical Center in both Global City and Quezon
14 City, the University of the East Ramon Magsaysay Memorial Medical Center Hospital,

1 Quirino Memorial Medical Center in Quezon City, and Sacred Heart Hospital of
2 Malolos in Bulacan, where she has made significant contributions in the field of
3 neurology; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Pabellano-Tiongson holds leadership roles in her field,
5 including as Head of the Neurophysiology Laboratory at Quirino Memorial Medical
6 Center and as the Fellowship Training Officer in Neuromuscular and Electrodiagnostic
7 Medicine at The Medical City, where she shares her expertise with the next generation
8 of neurologists; and

9 **WHEREAS**, in addition to her clinical and leadership roles, Dr. Pabellano-
10 Tiongson is committed to academic excellence as a part-time Assistant Professor at the
11 University of the East Ramon Magsaysay College of Medicine, where she imparts
12 knowledge and guidance to future physicians; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Pabellano-Tiongson actively contributes to the Philippine
14 medical community, serving as a Board Member and former Secretary of the Philippine
15 Society of Clinical Neurophysiology, a member of the Neuromuscular Council of the
16 Philippine Neurological Association, and as a Fellow of the Philippine Neurological
17 Association since 2011; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Pabellano-Tiongson has completed extensive training,
19 including a Clinical Neurophysiology/Electromyography Fellowship at St. Luke's
20 Medical Center Institute of Neurosciences and an Adult Neurology Residency at the
21 University of the East Ramon Magsaysay Memorial Medical Center, where she served
22 as Chief Neurology Resident; and

23 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Pabellano-Tiongson has a special interest in neuropathy and
24 pain management and has co-authored numerous papers on these topics, including
25 studies on Guillain-Barré syndrome, dementia management, peripheral neuropathy
26 among diabetic patients, and stroke management, contributing valuable research to the
27 field of neurology; and

28 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Pabellano-Tiongson's dedication to advancing medical
29 knowledge is matched by her commitment to patient care, her role as a devoted mother

1 of two, and her pursuit of holistic wellness as an active yoga practitioner, reflecting her
2 commitment to a balanced and mindful approach to life and work; now therefore, be it
