



1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI SIETTE NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** Kimberly was born to Robert and Guadalupe Kaible in
4 Huntingburg, Indiana, and is married to Rogel Edusma, with whom she shares three (3)
5 children, Mason, Micah, and Malia; and

6 **WHEREAS,** Kimberly moved to Guam with her family as a young girl, attended
7 Lyndon B. Johnson Elementary School, Harmon Loop Elementary School, Carlos L.
8 Taitano Elementary School, Agueda I. Johnston Middle School and graduated from
9 John F. Kennedy High School; and

10 **WHEREAS,** Kimberly graduated from the University of Guam with a Bachelor
11 of Science in Nursing Degree; and

12 **WHEREAS,** upon receiving her degree, Kimberly started her nursing career
13 with the Guam Department of Public Health and Social Services as a Community Health
14 Nurse and was assigned as a District Nurse and supported home health visits for the
15 maternal and women health programs before transferring to the Department of
16 Education on September 11, 1995, working at Maria Ulloa Elementary School until her
17 retirement; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Kimberly was a Basic Life Support (BLS) instructor, having
2 trained and certified hundreds of Department of Education (GDOE) employees; a
3 Pediatric Emergency Assessment Recognition and Stabilization (PEARS) instructor, a
4 University of Guam (UOG) Nursing Preceptor, guiding student nurses assigned in a
5 school setting; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Kimberly received special recognition for Division/School of the
7 Year by GDOE in January 2015; was recognized by the National Association of School
8 Nurses (NASN) in June 2015; was a MagPro 2015 Nominee and Awardee under the
9 DOE School Health Counselors and School Nurses Unit of the Year; received a Special
10 Recognition Award under the Congressional Award of School Nursing in May 2017;
11 was a MagPro 2017 nominee and awardee; and was recognized with two (2) Legislative
12 Resolutions in May of 2017 and August 2023; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Kimberly completed the Response to Radiological/Nuclear WMD
14 Course in June 2024, earned National Certification as a School Nurse (NCSN) in
15 November 2020, and was instrumental in supporting DPHSS during the COVID-19
16 pandemic; now therefore, be it

17 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'trentai Siette Na*
18 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize
19 Kimberly Dawn Kaible Edusma on her retirement from the Guam Department of
20 Education and commends her for her thirty-one (31) years of service to the Government
