



3           **WHEREAS**, Julie Kim Salas lives in the village of Dededo, is married to Joaquin  
4 Blas Salas and is the mother of Dylan and Kaitlin; and

5           **WHEREAS**, Julie was born to Joe and Ok Yon Kim in Daegu, South Korea and  
6 moved to Guam with her family in 1977 where she was raised in the villages of Tumon  
7 and Dededo; and

8           **WHEREAS**, growing up, Julie attended Lyndon B. Johnson Elementary School,  
9 Maria Ulloa Elementary School, Pedro C. Lujan Elementary School, Dededo Middle  
10 School and John F. Kennedy High School before attending the University of Guam  
11 where she received her Bachelor of Elementary Education Degree and Master of  
12 Language and Literacy Degree; and

13           **WHEREAS**, Julie's career with the Government of Guam began in January of  
14 1995 at Upi Elementary School where she taught kindergarten and the fifth grade; and

15           **WHEREAS**, Julie served as the Direct Instruction Coordinator and Curriculum  
16 Coordinator at Upi Elementary School from August 2003 to May of 2014 before  
17 becoming the Assistant Principal in August 2014; and

1           **WHEREAS**, Julie spent the next three years as Assistant Principal of Upi  
2 Elementary School before becoming Acting Principal in 2017; and

3           **WHEREAS**, in August of 2018, Julie became the Principal of Upi Elementary  
4 School where she remained until her retirement at the end of this year, spending her  
5 entire career at the same school, devoted to her students and her Totot family who are  
6 grateful for her leadership and wish her well upon her retirement; now therefore, be it

7           **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'trentai Siette Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,  
8 on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize Julie Kim Salas on her retirement from the
