1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'TRENTAI SIETTE NA LIHESLATURAN***
2 ***GUÅHAN*:**

3 **WHEREAS**, John-Eddie Quitugua Moser, a proud son of Guam, is a graduate of
4 George Washington High School, where he excelled academically as Salutatorian of his
5 class of over 250 students in 2008; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Moser pursued higher education at the University of Guam, earning
7 a Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice with a minor in Military Science in 2013,
8 demonstrating a strong commitment to academic excellence and leadership
9 development; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Moser began his professional career as a Fire Support Specialist
11 (13F) in the U.S. Army National Guard (Guam), where he provided critical advisory
12 and operational support in an Infantry Regiment, planning and coordinating fire support
13 training, including close air support, mortars, and field artillery. During this time, he
14 earned recognition as a Distinguished Honor Graduate from Advanced Individual
15 Training and served as a cadet through the Guam ROTC program, showcasing his
16 leadership and dedication; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Moser's military career advanced through several prestigious roles,
18 including serving as a Military Police Platoon Leader in Camp Walker, South Korea,
19 where he led 45 Soldiers in operations ensuring readiness and safety for over 12,000

1 individuals. Notably, he also served as the officer-in-charge for response forces during
2 critical operations across the Korean Peninsula; and

3 **WHEREAS**, as a Military Police Logistics Manager at Fort Bliss, Texas, Moser
4 excelled in managing sustainment plans for an organization of over 800 personnel,
5 overseeing multimillion-dollar budgets, and implementing professional development
6 programs that set new standards for excellence. His leadership earned his team
7 commendations, including being rated the best logistics team among multiple units; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Moser's civilian career began with the same level of excellence he
9 exhibited in the military. At Marathon Petroleum Corporation, he served as Transport
10 Operations Supervisor, managing a fleet of over 70 personnel and \$25 million in assets.
11 His strategies led to a 24% increase in revenue per hour and an 11% reduction in
12 operational costs, demonstrating his ability to drive efficiency and profitability; and

13 **WHEREAS**, as Implementation Manager for ADP, Moser managed a team
14 tasked with executing strategic projects, fostering collaborative environments, and
15 mentoring associates for professional growth. His leadership extended beyond
16 operational efficiency to cultivating a positive workplace culture that empowered his
17 team; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Moser's entrepreneurial spirit led to the establishment of
19 Ambassadors of the Art (AOA) Academy in El Paso, Texas. As Owner and Head
20 Instructor, he created a unique community-focused fitness center specializing in
21 innovative training methods, including landmine training, strength and conditioning,
22 and combat sports. His academy has become a beacon for promoting personal growth,
23 health, and excellence; and

24 **WHEREAS**, Moser has also distinguished himself as a certified personal trainer
25 through the National Academy of Sports Medicine (NASM). His certifications in
26 nutritional coaching, behavioral change, performance enhancement, and corrective
27 exercise exemplify his holistic approach to fitness and wellness, further enriching the
28 lives of those he serves; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Moser’s contributions extend beyond his professional
2 accomplishments. His dedication to fostering leadership, community engagement, and
3 personal development embodies the values and traditions of the people of Guam. He
4 serves as an inspiration to many, demonstrating how hard work, innovation, and service
5 can create lasting impact; and

6 **WHEREAS**, throughout his career, Moser has consistently demonstrated an
7 unwavering commitment to excellence, innovation, and service. His accomplishments
8 reflect the highest ideals of leadership, resilience, and dedication to both his homeland
9 and the broader global community; now therefore, be it

10 **RESOLVED**, that the *I Mina'trentai Siette Na Liheslaturan Guahan* does
11 hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guahan* and the people of Guam, recognize John-
12 Eddie Quitugua Moser for his outstanding contributions, dedication, and service to the
