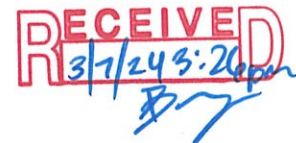
Bill No. 226-37 (COR) amends the Sanitation law to provide for the expiration of sanitary permits one (1) year from the date of issuance, as opposed to June 30 of every year for all permits. By staggering sanitary permit renewals, as was previously done with business license renewals at the Department of Revenue and Taxation, the goal is to reduce administrative bottlenecks within the Department of Public Health and Social Services.

My Administration continues to prioritize supporting and developing government efficiency initiatives to streamline and improve services for all.

For these reasons, I am signing Bill No. 226-37 (COR) into law as **Public Law 37-80**.





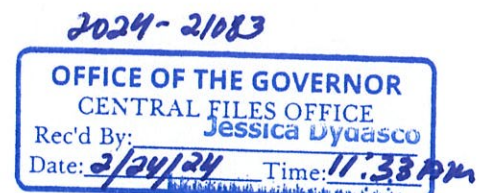

**AN ACT TO *AMEND* § 21103 OF CHAPTER 21, TITLE 10,
GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
REQUIRING SANITARY PERMITS TO BE RENEWED
EVERY YEAR ON THE ANNIVERSARY DATE OF
ISSUE.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** § 21103 of Chapter 21, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated, is
3 *amended* to read as follows:

4 **“§ 21103. Form, Duration and Charges for Permit and Annual**
5 **Renewal.**

1 The form of the permit shall be prescribed by the Director. All permits
2 applicable thereto shall be issued on an annual basis and, regardless of when
3 issued, shall expire one (1) year after the date for which issued or renewed.

4 All permits applicable thereto which are already in existence prior to
5 the enactment of this law shall be renewed on the month consistent with the
6 month they originally attained their permit. The Director shall have up to
7 twelve (12) months from the enactment of this law to amend the renewal dates
8 of these sanitary permits to conform with the renewal date outlined in the
9 Section.

10 Sanitary permits for the *temporary workforce housing* category, as
11 defined in Chapter 26A of this Title, shall adhere to the permit renewal
12 schedule pursuant to 10 GCA § 26A104.

13 The fee for the sanitary permit shall be determined by the Director by
14 regulation and shall be collected by him or his designee. The falsification of
15 an application for a sanitary permit may result in the suspension or revocation
16 of the sanitary permit in accordance with 10 GCA § 21109.”
