An Act to add Section 4112 to the Government Code relating to jury service by employees of the government of Guma.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAN:
Section 1. Section 4112 is hereby added to the Government
Code to read:

"Section 1112. ABSENCE FOR JURY SERVICE; CONTINUATION OF COMPENSATION: JURY FEES: PAYABLE TO GOVERNMENT OF GUAN. The compensation of any employee of the government of Guan who may be salled upon for jury service in any court in the territory of Guan, shall not be diminished during the term of such jury service by reason of such absence, nor shall such period of service be deducted from the time allowed for any leave of absence authorised by law, provided that all compensation serned by such employee for such jury service is paid to the government of Guan."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
