

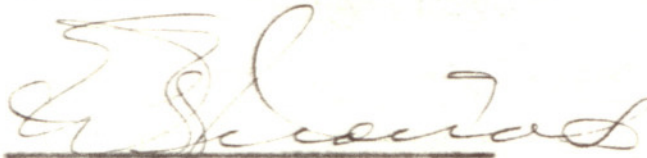
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

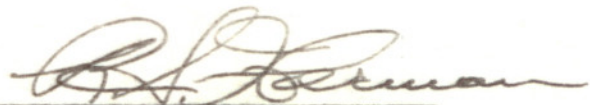

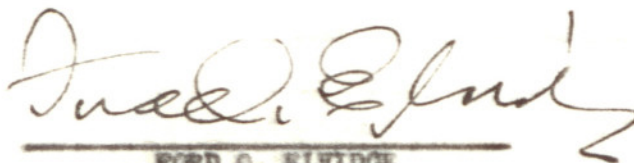

Introduced by
Committee on Judiciary,

An Act to add Section 4112 to the Govern-
ment Code relating to jury service by
employees of the government of Guam.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 4112 is hereby added to the Government

Code to read:

"Section 4112. ABSENCE FOR JURY SERVICE; CONTINUATION
OF COMPENSATION: JURY FEES: PAYABLE TO GOVERNMENT OF
GUAM. The compensation of any employee of the government
of Guam who may be called upon for jury service in any
court in the territory of Guam, shall not be diminished
during the term of such jury service by reason of such
absence, nor shall such period of service be deducted
from the time allowed for any leave of absence authorized
by law, provided that all compensation earned by such
employee for such jury service is paid to the government
of Guam."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
