BE IT REACTED BY THE PROPIE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The sum of One Hundred Six Thousand Two Hundred Forty-five Dollars (\$106,245.00) to be allocated as follows:

Personal Services	\$ 44,625.00
Travel	9,000.00
Other Contractual Services	30,820.00
Supplies and Materials	3,300.00
Equipment	1,500.00
Hiscellaneous	8,000.00
Contingent	9,000.00

or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any General Fund Surplus in the Treasury of Guam not otherwise appropriated, for the contingent expenses of the Guam Legislature for the calendar year 1956, including expenses of committees.

Section 2. The sums allocated for various purposes in Section 1 of this Act shall at all times be subject to reallocation at the direction and upon the authority of the Committee on Rules of the Guam Legislature.

Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
